_____ Statement of Leadership and Career Goals:

Address your leadership beliefs, philosophy, accomplishments and capabilities in each of three areas:

- a. leadership for learning
- b. leadership for equity
- c. leadership for accountability

(Each area is to be addressed under a separate heading.)

Career Goals: describe your career goals.

_____ Professional Vita or Resume that includes the following:

- a. Colleges or universities attended
- b. Educational degrees held, including major/minor (Master's Degree is required)
- c. Work history in chronological order, beginning with your current position
- d. Leadership experiences (must have at least 3 years of leadership experience)
- e. Professional involvement
- f. Awards and honors

_____ 3 professional references (form found online through ApplyYourself)

- One reference must come from your current principal or supervisor.
- Obtain at least one reference from someone who can attest to your academic abilities.

Do not send references from friends, family members or clergy.

Encourage those providing references to upload a more lengthy statement. Obtain references from those who can attest to your work ethic and scholarly accomplishments. Statements should address your leadership potential.

_____ Transcripts: Unofficial copies of your transcripts may be uploaded into the application site. These can be used until your official transcripts arrive.

Request that **all** undergraduate and graduate transcripts from previous study be submitted to the admissions office. For admission to graduate study at VCU, the Graduate School requires a minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0. For students with earned graduate degrees from accredited institutions, the graduate GPA may be the primary basis for consideration. The Educational Leadership expected graduate level GPA should be 3.5 or better. **Official transcripts must be submitted from the previous college/institution to VCU.** Transcripts can be traditionally mailed in sealed envelopes or emailed.

All candidates must have **official** MAT scores mailed to VCU. **Request this mailing at the time you take the exam.** VCU's score recipient code for the MAT is 1788.

* The expected score on the MAT should be in the 50th percentile (generally around 400) or better.

If you have taken the MAT within the last five years, contact ETS or Pearson and request that an *official copy* be mailed to VCU Graduate Admissions Office at the above address.
