Please note that **testing requirements have changed** for our VCU School of Education initial license teacher preparation programs. As of **December 1, 2019**, please review the **NEW** testing requirements to prepare for your Virginia license teacher preparation requirements.

Undergraduate Teacher Preparation Testing Requirements

Testing Requirement	Prior to December 1, 2019 Students applying for Spring or summer 2020	After December 1, 2019 Students applying Fall 2020 or later
Math	PRAXIS Core Math OR SAT Math Score OR ACT Math Score	SAT Math Score OR ACT Math Score
Language/Reading	VCLA	SAT Reading OR ACT Reading <i>AND</i> VCLA (required for teacher prep, not B.S.Ed. admissions)
Undergraduate application and pre-admission to teacher prep requirements .		

Graduate Teacher Preparation Testing Requirements

Testing Requirement	Prior to December 1, 2019 Students applying for Spring or summer 2020	After December 1, 2019 Students applying Fall 2020 or later
Math	PRAXIS Core Math (150) OR SAT Math Score (560 minimum) OR ACT Math Score (22 minimum)	GRE OR SAT Math Score OR ACT Math Score
Language/Reading	VCLA (470 minimum)	GRE <i>AND</i> VCLA
Online application and pre-admission to teacher prep requirements .		

Please note that SAT, ACT, MAT and GRE scores must be taken within the last five years in order for students to request official copies of the scores for state licensure. **We do not have official cut-off scores as we are committed to a holistic admissions process.**
