

Certificate in Disability Leadership - Va-LEND Program

Application Deadlines: Fall (Aug. 1), Summer (Mar. 15) & Spring (Nov. 1) Note: Fall is the typical start semester. Contact <u>soeinfo@vcu.edu</u> if you hope to start in spring and summer.

Step 1: **Va-LEND application:** Applications are available in March each year from the Va-LEND website to start the certificate program **each fall**. Send the Va-LEND application to <u>valend@vcu.edu</u> or simply complete it using the online form. *Please note:* this program is a cohort consortium and applications are accepted and reviewed each year in late spring/early summer. Once accepted by the LEND program, you will be notified to begin your certificate application below. Contact <u>valend@vcu.edu</u> for any questions.

Step 1: **Create Your Application Account:** Go to this website <u>https://www.vcu.edu/admissions/apply/graduate/</u> and below "Graduate Programs", choose "2024 Applications" then "Application for all other graduate programs".

Step 3: **Statement of Intent:** VCU requires a written statement of intent for all graduate program applicants. Copy and paste your answers to the Va-LEND application into a document to upload for this requirement.

Step 4: **References:** The system has an area for you to submit the names and emails of three letters of reference. Since you have already been accepted into the Va-LEND program (see above), you will input the following three names and emails for your references:

- VaLEND (valend@vcu.edu)

Step 4: **Transcripts:** You can upload PDF copies of your *unofficial* transcripts for the review/decision process. You will be required to submit official academic transcripts from **all institutions you have attended** in order to enroll in the Certificate in Disability Leadership. If you are currently enrolled as a VCU student in another program, if you have unofficial copies, please upload these to expedite the process, if not, admissions will manually pull your transcripts.

Step 6: **Submit application fee and <u>push submit</u>**: You have the option to submit without the application fee yet your application will not be moved forward for review until the application fee is submitted.

Step 7: **Receiving and accepting your admissions decision**: Your official admissions letter will come from VCU graduate admissions and you will **accept your offer through your VCU admissions online portal**. This will allow the system to create a formal account that will allow you to register. **Review the <u>Accepted Graduate Student</u>** <u>Checklist</u> for critical next steps as you transition to VCU.

Step 8: **Graduation applications** must be submitted at the **beginning of your final semester** in the Va-LEND program. This is **time sensitive**. The paperwork for the graduation will be sent to your VCU email address. If you are currently enrolled in another graduate program, you must submit a graduate application for both and graduate from the certificate either before or concurrently with your home program. Note: Trainees not in a degree program only have to do one application for graduation for the certificate.
