

<u>M.Ed. in Ed Leadership - Administration and Supervision</u> concentration and <u>Post-Masters</u> Certificate for Educational Leadership

Application Deadline: Fall semester start only (April 1)

Step 1: **Create Your Application Account:** Go to this website <u>https://www.vcu.edu/admissions/apply/graduate/</u> and below "Graduate Programs", choose "2024 Applications" then "Application for all other graduate programs". *Please note: Please choose the M.Ed. if you have not completed a masters degree, and Post-Masters if you have.*

Step 2: **Statement of Intent:** VCU requires that prospective students provide a written statement of purpose for all graduate program applicants. Please answer the following questions:

- This is a program focusing on leadership. What are your reasons for applying to this program and what are the goals you will strive to achieve?
- What evidence do you have that you are an effective educator?
- Describe a situation when you were asked to solve a problem. What did you do? What was the outcome? What did you learn?
- There are numerous reform movements in education. Choose one you are either for or against and explain why.

Step 3: Academic or Professional References: The system has an area for you to submit the names and emails of three letters of reference. This will send an email directly to the recommenders to fill out a short survey and upload your letter of recommendation. Note: You can add a note to suggest areas you would like your reference to highlight to strengthen your application.

Step 4: **Transcripts:** You can upload PDF copies of your *unofficial* transcripts for the review/decision process. You will be required to submit official academic transcripts from **all institutions you have attended** in order to enroll. If you have completed a program at VCU, if you have unofficial copies, please upload these to expedite the process, if not, admissions will manually pull your transcripts. Step 5: Active Teaching License and CV Resume: The add-on endorsement in Virginia requires an active teaching license and at least two years of experience in a school setting, which must be in a licensed instructional personnel position. Please upload a copy of your license AND current CV/Resume. For your CV/Resume, include institutions attended including program, work history highlighting at least two years of teaching experience, professional/community service involvement and any applicable awards and honors.

Step 6: **Submit application fee and <u>push submit</u>**: You have the option to submit without the application fee yet your application will not be moved forward for review until the application fee is submitted.

Step 7: **Receiving and accepting your admissions decision**: Your official admissions letter will come from VCU graduate admissions and you will **accept your offer through your VCU admissions online portal**. This will allow the system to create a formal account that will allow you to register.
